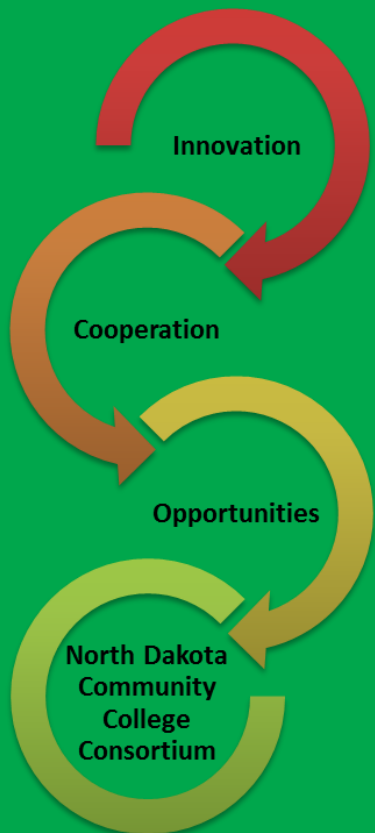

# Instructional Technology Boot Camp

June 5-7, 2012

North Dakota State College of Science

## Camp Purpose

During the camp you will apply instructional technology to a learning opportunity. By identifying the need (challenge) and the learning objective prior to selecting the technology, the emphasis is on learning, not a specific technology. We encourage participants to design a complete strategy in addressing the technology based learning opportunity by not only selecting the best technology to use, but also to state how it will be easily accessed and how students will be held accountable for the content. We encourage participants to partner with someone, either within their department or the college.

## What's In It For Me?

You are responsible for attending meetings and creating a learning object (fancy word for a lesson using technology). In return for your time, you will receive skills that you can use for a lifetime of teaching and tools that can be applied directly to your teaching style and methods. You will have the support and assistance of the NDSCS Instructional Technology department and experienced boot camp staffers. After attending the Technology Boot Camp, you will receive a \$500 stipend.



## What Are My Duties?

- Attend the Boot Camp according to the schedule. It is a 21 hour commitment over three days.
- Make an honest effort at applying a technology solution to an application for your class. Staff will assist with the technology.
- Be willing to share what you've learned with others.
- Assess the effectiveness of your project in the classroom.
